Information and Rules

Chimera is a student-led organization dedicated to producing a yearly journal of the highest quality art, literature, film and animation created at Edinboro University. Chimera invites participation from currently enrolled students of all academic backgrounds, placing no limits on subject, style, or form.

Work that is accepted will be featured in the journal as well as exhibited at the Chimera Soirée held at the Erie ArtMuseum.

Jurying:

Saturday, October 14th from 12pm to 3pm on the top floor of Doucette Hall.

Submissions will take place from 12pm to 2pm.

Voting will take place from 2pm to 3pm.

All votes will be totaled at the close of jurying.

Work will be available for pick-up at 6:00pm.

Submission and Voting Rules:

- Applicants must be a currently enrolled undergrad/grad student and must be able to provide proof (student ID)
- Each student may submit up to 3 pieces
- · All pieces submitted for consideration must be displayed as it would in a gallery space
- Each artist MUST include a PRINTED artist statement of 150 words maximum, WORK WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED WITHOUT A PRINTED ARTIST STATEMENT
- Each artist will have to fill out an entry form that will ask the following information:
 - Artist's name
 - Email
 - Medium of the piece being submitted
 - Dimensions of the piece Height, width and depth in inches (there will be measuring tape available at jurying)
- Each artist who submits work will be given 10 votes
- Artists may not vote for their own work, and may not vote for the same piece more than once
- Votes will be tallied by members of the Chimera XV Promotional Team in the presence of faculty advisors.
- 5 ranked alternates will be selected. In the event of a tie, the deciding vote will go to the faculty advisors.
- If you are unable to attend the jurying, you can submit work by proxy. However, the proxy MUST have a printed copy of your artist statement, fill out your entry form and your votes will be forfeited.

Pick Up/Transportation:

- Accepted work will be moved to another, secure location where it will be photographed for the publication.
- Artist's whose work is accepted will be required to make transportation arrangements for their piece to the gallery setup on Sunday, November 5th, at 12pm at the Erie Art Museum
- If you are not able to transport your work, members of the Chimera Teams will do so. However, you will be required to sign a release form that states the Chimera team will not be held responsible for any damage sustained to his or her work.
- · Work not selected, must be picked up between 6pm and 7pm the day of jurying.
